Report of the One Day Workshop Programme

Kharakor (Librarian/ Convenor) of the Library Advisory Committee organised a One Day Workshop on the theme "Exploring the Usability of E- Resources: With Reference to Subscription- Based and Open- Access Resources" on the 15th September 2021. The programme started at 10:00 am onwards in the college hall.

The programme was hosted by Miss D. Kharakor librarian of the college. The workshop commenced with a speech from the Principal of the college Dr. S. Basu where she highlighted that as an institution library acts like a powerhouse especially during the pandemic. It has helped in cultivating e- culture, e- resources and caters to online availability of books and resources in the internet. E- Resources can enhance and improve the knowledge of the subject and in turn transfer it to the students.

The chief guest Sir Spainborlang Kharshandi (Member of the Governing Body) delivered a speech and expressed his appreciation to the team of library for organizing a workshop and bringing resource persons for giving better insight information.
