ANNUAL REPORT OF HISTORY DEPARTMENT

The department of History here produced its annual report of the year 2022.

1. The department had started the even semester classes in the month of February 2022.

2. The department started with the department meeting on 09/03/2022 at the college staffs room regarding division of the syllabus, allotted classes for all the teachers, internal test and assignments of the students as well as the ICT classes to be taken by each staff. Minutes has been recorded as per usual. All internal tests (both first and second tests) and assignment were done and completed on time.

3. Classes for Odd semester were commenced on 18/7/2022. The department held its meeting on 24/08/2022 and discussed on the division of the syllabus, classes (included ICT classes), internal test and assignments for the students of Odd semester. Mentors and Mentee are formed within the Department with a division of four groups of eight students under each group for Odd semesters. It was also decided that all teachers are mentors for all Honours students. Records of the same are kept as usual.

4. In this semester also, all internal tests (both first and second tests), and assignment were done and completed on time.

5. The department submitted on time all Internal Assessment marks (IA) of the

students of all semesters (both Even and Odd semester) as requested by the Convener of the Examination committee.

6. In order to enhance more knowledge for the students on various topics from the syllabus, the department has taken around 6 ICT classes for all semesters and the same were recorded in the circular register.

7. Departmental meetings were held around 5 times in the college premises for the Academic year 2022-2023 and minutes were recorded in the minute's register of the department.

8. The Department of History has recorded the enrolment of the students during the Academic year 2022-2023 for both who are opted for **Honors** as well as **Generals**. Here is the table as below:
