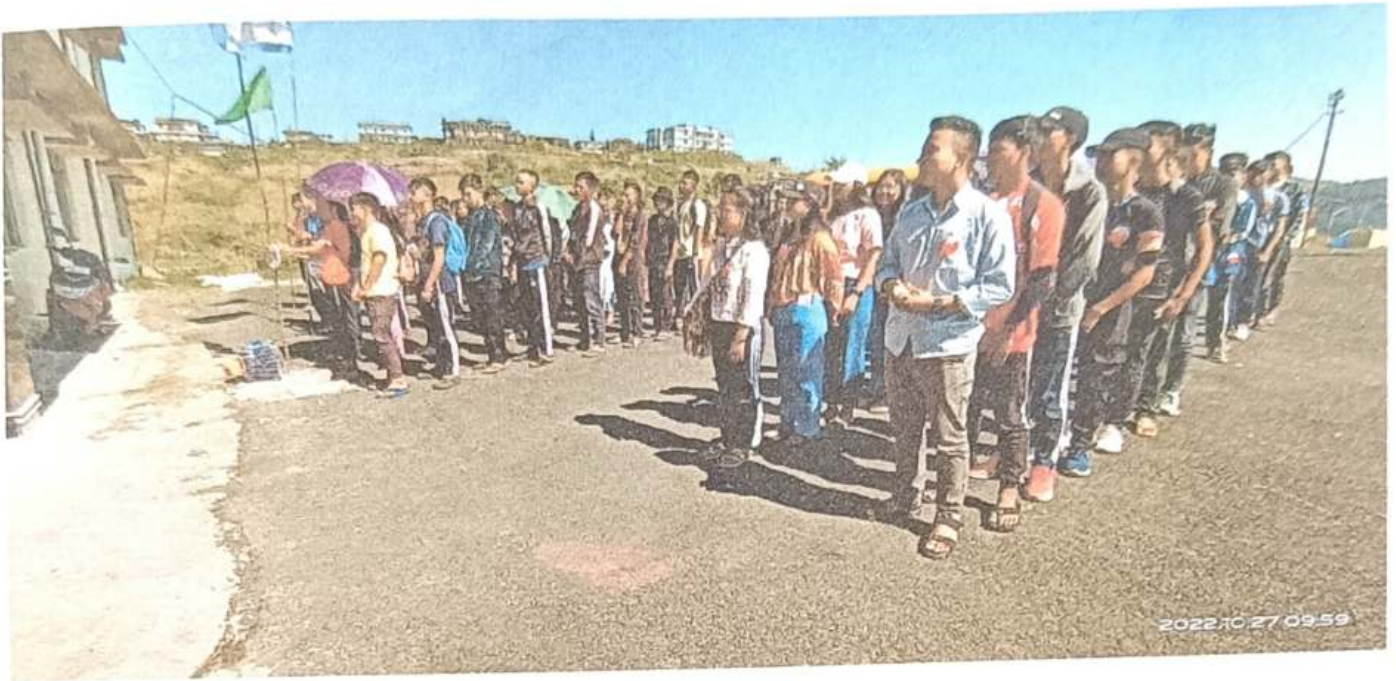

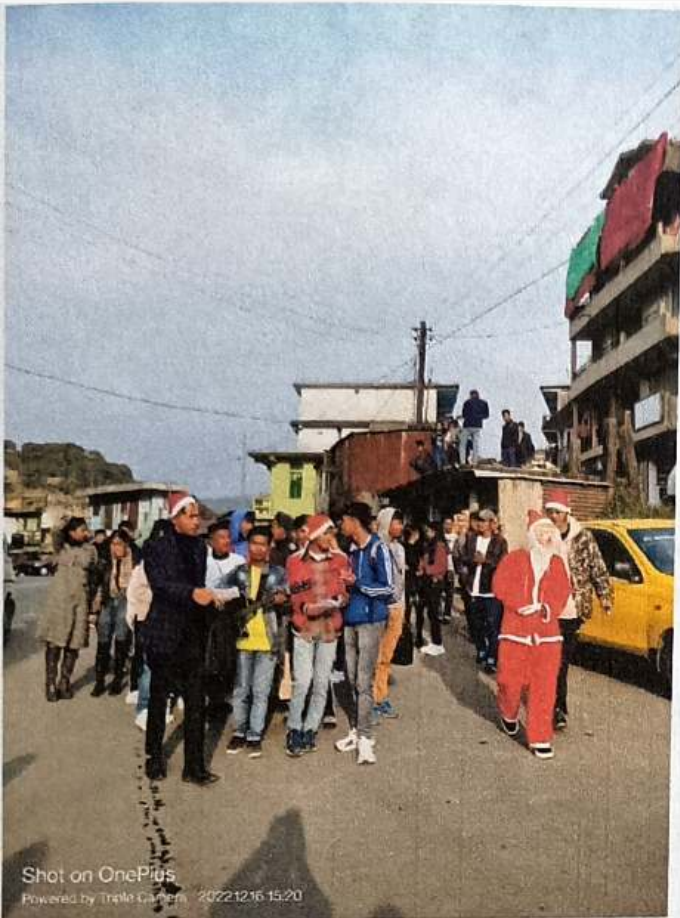

We left Shillong on the 28th January 2023 at around 7:30 A.M. On our way to Guwahati we stopped at Nongpoh for breakfast, we reached Guwahati railway station at 10:30 A.M. We reached the destination on the next morning i.e the 29th January 2023 and our accommodation was arranged at Meghalaya House (Kasba). We started our Kolkata tour on the same day in the afternoon. On the 30th January 2023 we went first for sightseeing to Nicco Park, and from there we proceeded to Science city, which is one of the largest and finest museums in the world where scientific instruments and scientific showpieces are beautifully displayed. On the next day, the 31st January 2023 we visited Victoria Memorial, one of the famous tourist places in the city.
